

Plant System - Markup

Activity

Students to take a photo of the plant (in the school garden) or as provided by the teacher. Use the markup function to label parts of the plant.

Upon completion, students to post the marked up photo onto SLS or cloud space for teacher to review or for class discussion.

Objectives



- Students can identify the different parts of plants and state their functions. - Leaf/ Stem/ Root
- Students show curiosity in exploring the surrounding plants and question what they find.




Extensions



- Connect the iPad to the Apple TV, to create "visualiser like" function, where teachers will be able to walk around and project students work on the screen for class discussion.
- With screen recording, students will be able to add voiceover to any image the annotate on.

Have a go



- 1 Open  app, and frame your subject, long press  to lock focus.

- 2 Tap  to take photo, tap the image box below the button  .
Alternatively, go to  and find the image.

- 3 Tap on edit on the top right corner of a photo. Tap on  and tap on  to call out the markup panel.

- 4 Change the colour or type of markup tools if needed



- 5  Press and hold on the pen to adjust the width of strokes. After markup, tap Done.
