

Mood Board

Use Keynote to Create a Mood Board

Activity

Prior to the process of creating art, students will put together a mood board to work through the thought process. This can help them to go through a more thoughtful thinking and planning process, and teacher can step in to support if students seem to be stuck. This would also support students to see that the art creation process is multi-dimensional, and they can take inspiration from ideas around them.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Draw from their observation and experience
- Present their own ideas and consider others' ideas in artworks and through art making
- Share their artworks, intentions and art making processes with others
- Convey information and ideas coherently for specific purposes and contexts



Extensions

Students can

- Work with a friend to create a mood board together
- Set a boundary as to where they can seek the inspiration from – such as a specific culture or country
- Narrow down the choice of colours to be used

Have a go



- 1 Open . Tap on + and select Choose a Theme. Select Basic White or Basic Black. A new presentation will open.
- 2 Tap on ⋮ and select . Open Safari. The two Apps are side by side. Navigate to a webpage for doing research. Tap on the | if you need more screen space for either App.
- 3 Use one finger and long hold on image until it seems to be floating. You can then drag it over to the Keynote.
- 4 You should see a green + appearing. Let go of your finger, and the image will be copied over.
- 5 Adjust the size of the image by tapping on the dot on the corner of the image. You can also move it around.
- 6 Keep adding images until you are done. Once it is completed, take a screenshot and upload it onto a different platform.

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
