

Recap on Learning

Using Keynote to Create Flashcards

Activity

Students will use the Keynote deck that was prepared by the teacher. Each page will represent one flashcard. There will be one word placed on each page. Teacher will also include image placeholder on each page, and students can replace these images with their own. They will then define the meaning of the words. They will form a sentence that includes the use of the new word learnt. This will help teachers to assess the students' learning and understanding.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Construct different forms of sentences
- Vary the way sentences are written
- Convey information and ideas clearly





Extensions

Students can

- Add audio recording to enrich the flashcards
- Create a GIF to express understanding of the sentence
- Create a short video clip to explain the meaning of the word

Have a go



- 1 Open . Select the file sent from teacher. Tap on ⊕ at the bottom right corner of image, then input your own image to represent the word.
- 2 Tap on ⊕, then  and select Drawing.
- 3 The toolbar will appear . Change the colour by tapping on the colours, change the line thickness by tapping on the tool. Draw on the first slide to create the first scene.
- 4 Tap on ⊕, and , then add shapes if necessary. Under Basic, select Text and that adds a textbox. You can type a sentence in accordingly.
- 5 Tap on ☺ and select Export, then Images. Adjust the Slide Range accordingly, and change the format to JPEG (High Quality) and tap on Export. Tap on Share and then Save Image.
- 6 The images will appear in your Photos library. You can insert it into another document or upload it to an online platform for sharing.

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
