

Explain Prepositions

Using Keynote to create GIF

Activity

Students will reflect on their learning of preposition and develop an understanding of how they may be able to explain it to a peer. They will use create a GIF to explain a scenario with the use of a preposition in it. Their peer will then guess what the preposition is.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Use prepositions to convey a variety of meaning
- Form preposition phrases
- Convey information and ideas coherently for specific purposes and contexts







Extensions

Students can

- Add audio explanation to the recording to add complexity to the scenario
- Make a movie with a storyline and highlight the use of prepositions in it
- Work in small groups to create preposition resources that they could then share with their schoolmates from a younger year level

Have a go



- 1 Open . Create a new document in Keynote. Tap on , then  and select Drawing.
- 2 The toolbar will appear . Change the colour by tapping on the colours, change the line thickness by tapping on the tool. Draw on the first slide to create the first scene. You can also select  and add shapes to it.
- 3 Tap on the slide and select Duplicate. Alternatively, tap on the slide and select Copy. Paste the slide below the first. Draw on the second slide to create the second scene.
- 4 Tap on the slide and select Duplicate. Alternatively, tap on the slide and select Copy. Paste the slide below the second. Draw on the third slide. Continue until the storyline is complete.
- 5 Tap on  and select Export, then Animated GIF. Change the Slide Range and tap on Export. Tap on Share and then Save Image.
- 6 The animated GIF will appear in your Photos library. You can insert it into another document or upload it to an online platform for sharing.

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
