Use Live Titles In Clips

Activity

To develop confidence and competence for oral reading, students will make use of Clips to record their own reading. They will make use of Live Titles to check in on their pronunciation and enunciation of words. They can also personalise the video by adding other elements (e.g. posters and stickers) to it.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Develop knowledge and awareness of features of speaking and representing
- Develop accuracy and fluency in speaking and representing
- Speak and represent confidently, coherently, for a variety of purposes, audiences, contexts and cultures










Extensions

Students can

- Share their video recordings with their friends to seek feedback on how they can read/communicate more effectively
- Add various Memojis to capture their emotions at different parts of the reading
- Create music in GarageBand and add it to the video to enhance the effects

Have a go



- 1 Go to Settings, General, Keyboard, and turn on Enable Dictation.
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- 2 Open . Tap on  and select . You will have the option to select how you would like your Live Titles to appear.
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- 3 To record, long press on  or flick it up so it becomes a . Speak normally as the recording happens.
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- 4 If there are errors, you can delete the square frame and re-record. You can also tap on the square frame, , and select Edit Text beside Live Titles to add the necessary punctuations.
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- 5 Tap on the  button to review your own recording. Tap on , then Save Video  and OK.
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- 6 The video will be saved in Photos library. It can then be uploaded onto an online platform for sharing.

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
