

Visual Note-Taking

Using Notes to do Visual Note-Taking

Activity

Students will put together information based on what they have learnt in a topic. Teacher can guide students on how they can put together a piece of visual note (such as the orientation of writing) and facilitate the process. They will use their handwriting to create the visual note.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Use words meaningfully in conjunction with semiotic modes
- Develop handwriting
- Write and represent to develop self-awareness and monitor learning strategies






Extensions

Students can

- Collaborate with their friends to create a piece of visual note
- Create a visual note in Pages and input text alongside handwriting
- Add a audio recording alongside the visual note to explain about key points

Have a go



- 1 Open  . Tap on  to start a new note. Tap on  to view it in full screen.
- 2 Tap on  to activate the tool bar  . Tap on the pen, highlighter or pencil and begin writing.
- 3 Tap on the pen, highlighter or pencil to change the thickness and opacity of the lines. Tap on the colour wheel to change the colour of the tools.
- 4 Use two fingers to scroll down as you continue creating your visual note.
- 5 You can tap on the striped pencil (located beside the ruler) and circle something that was written. You can then move that around or change the colour of it.
- 6 Once you are done, take a screenshot, select the thumbnail, and tap on Full Page. You can now share it or upload it.

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
