Create Unique Shapes

Activity

After observing specific paint techniques, students will consider how they may be able to translate that into the creation of new shapes. They will then use the new shapes to create an art piece based on the paint technique that they have just learnt. This will also challenge their creativity as they have to explore how they could form the shapes.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Distinguish the visual qualities in what they see
- Draw from their observation and experience
- Explore and discover different ways to use tools to make art
- Generate ideas and explore different pathways that lead to solutions







Extensions

Students can

- Work with a partner to create a shape together
- Upload the work onto a Padlet wall and observe the shapes created by their friends, and choose to integrate those shapes into their art creation
- Design their own characters using shapes

Have a go



- 1 Open . Tap on +, then  and select a shape. Drag any of the blue dots to enlarge or reduce the shape.
- 2 Tap on +, then  and select another shape. You may want to change the colour of the second shape so that it may make it easier for you to see it visually. Tap on , Style and change it to a different colour.
- 3 Add more shapes and align them accordingly until they look like the new shape that you will like to create.
- 4 Use one finger to tap on one shape and keep it there. Use the other finger to tap on all other shapes so that they are all selected.
- 5 Tap on , Arrange and Combine Shapes. If it does not look like what you want, tap on  to undo the process and choose a new way to Combine Shapes or re-arrange the shapes again.
- 6 If you will like to use the shape in the future, tap on it and select Add to Shapes. It will be added to My Shapes. Long press on it to rename the shape.

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
