

# Comic Strip

## Add Filters to Images

### Activity

In the process of creating a comic strip, students can add filters to change the mood of the storyline. They will draw three scenes for the comic strip. Each scene can be saved as an individual image. The filters will be added in Clips, which they can save and then add to a platform where they can create the three-panel comic strip as a final piece.

### Objectives

Students will be able to

- Draw from their observation and experience
- Explore and discover different ways to use materials and tools to make art
- Present their own ideas in artwork and through art making
- Share their artworks, intentions and art making process with others













### Extensions

Students can

- Create up to a six-panel comic strip
- Add audio recording to the comic strip and create it as a video in Clips
- Share their comic strip with their friends on a collaboration tool for them to guess the key message
- Offer feedback on their friends' comic strips

## Have a go



- 1 Open . Select  on the top right corner to create a new note. Tap on  to expand the note to full page.
- 2 Once drawing is done for the first panel, tap on  and select Save Image . Tap on  on the top right corner to create a new note for the second panel.
- 3 Follow the same steps to create the image for the three panels.
- 4 Open . Tap on  to insert the first image. Tap on  and select Filters . Tap on , then Save Image  and OK. The image will be saved in Photos library.
- 5 Do the same for the other 2 images. The images can be inserted onto a slide on Keynote to create the three-panel comic strip.
- 6 You can then upload it to an online platform for sharing.

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
