

Word Poster

Using Keynote to Create Word Posters

Activity

Students will use the Keynote deck that was prepared by the teacher. Each page will have one key word on it. Students will use the split view function to drag and drop images from an online source to represent the meaning of the word.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Use and/or combine information from texts to create new understandings and ideas, according to purpose, audience, context and culture
- Organise facts, ideas and/or points of view in a way appropriate to the mode of delivery, purpose and audience
- Verifies the accuracy, credibility and currency of information across multiple sources



Extensions

Students can

- Work in small groups to prepare a word poster together
- Add animations to include graphic representation of how the images make sense in relation to each other

Have a go



- 1 Open . Select the file sent from teacher. Tap on ... and select . Open Safari.
- 2 The two Apps are side by side. Navigate to a webpage for doing research. Tap on the | if you need more screen space for either App.
- 3 Use one finger and long hold on image until it seems to be floating. You can then drag it over to the Keynote.
- 4 You should see a green + appearing. Let go of your finger, and the image will be copied over.
- 5 Adjust the size of the image by tapping on the dot on the corner of the image. You can also move it around.
- 6 Once it is completed, take a screenshot and upload it onto a different platform.

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
