

Compiling Research on a Topic

Using GarageBand to record a Podcast

Activity

Students will work on a topic for research and put together relevant information that they can share with an audience. They will need to consider what are the key areas that are relevant for sharing and how the information can be meaningfully shared in a logical and coherent manner. Students will then record their voice into a podcast for sharing.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Recognise that non-fluency features of spoken language (e.g., hesitations, pauses, fillers) contribute to the meaning of an utterance
- Recognise and use appropriate prosodic features for expression and fluency
- Develop and organise ideas for speaking and representing


Extensions

Students can




- Include voices of other team members to create a joint podcast
- Add background music into the podcast
- Add visuals into the podcast to create a movie

Have a go







- 1 Open . Tap on + and select Live Loops.

- 2 Flick left/right to Audio Recorder. Tap on Voice.

- 3 Tap on  to turn it off, so that it turns grey . Tap Record  and start speaking.

- 4 Slow down the speaking speed slightly. Pause between each sentence.

- 5 Tap on  when you are done. Tap on  once done. Select the file, and Share .
- 6 Tap Song, then tap Share. Select Open in, and select Save to Files . You can now upload it onto a different platform.

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
