

Process of Art Making

Use Time-Lapse to Capture A Process

Activity

Students will use time-lapse to capture their art making process. They will set up the iPad such that it is in a good position to capture what they are doing and focus on the key elements of their art piece. The eventual time-lapse video will offer feedback on the process and the need for any additional modifications.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Ask questions and gather information to make meaning of what they see
- Share their artworks, intentions and art making processes with others
- Reflect on his/her thoughts, attitudes, behaviours and actions during his/her learning experiences and determine the modifications required








Extensions

Have a go



- 1 Open . Under Activities, tap on +. You will have a folder that you can tap on to rename. Tap on + and it will bring you to a new page where you will see many brushes on the left.
- 2 You can change the colour at the bottom right of the screen. Tap on  and move the slider to adjust the opacity and size of brush strokes.
- 3 You can choose to use your finger or an Apple Pencil to do your drawing. Explore with the brushes to observe what you can do with them.
- 4 Tap on  and  and you can insert an image into your drawing. Move it around and tap on  at the bottom of screen when it is in place.
- 5 Tap on  and Save Image  when you are done.
- 6 You will find it in the Photos library. You can then insert it into another document or upload it to an online platform for sharing.

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
