Explore With Different Types Of Brushes

Activity

Students will explore with colour mixing and notice how the use of different types of brushes, strokes and blending can result in different results. This encourages them to consider about how the different tools can create art pieces that look different. They will then create an art piece with the use of primary, secondary and intermediate colours.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Distinguish the visual qualities in what they see
- Explore and discover different ways to use tools to make art
- Share their artworks, intentions and making processes with others
- Generate ideas and explore different pathways that lead to solutions








Extensions

Students can

- Observe various types of art forms (such as impressionism) and consider the right tools to use for the art piece
- Work with a friend and each create half of an art piece and put them together, and discuss how each person create their art piece

Have a go



- 1 Open . Under Activities, tap on +. You will have a folder that you can tap on to rename. Tap on + and it will bring you to a new page where you will see many brushes on the left.
- 2 You can change the colour at the bottom right of the screen. Tap on  and move the slider to adjust the opacity and size of brush strokes.
- 3 You can choose to use your finger or an Apple Pencil to do your drawing. Explore with the brushes to observe what you can do with them.
- 4 Tap on  and  and you can insert an image into your drawing. Move it around and tap on  at the bottom of screen when it is in place.
- 5 Tap on  and Save Image  when you are done.
- 6 You will find it in the Photos library. You can then insert it into another document or upload it to an online platform for sharing.

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
