

# Descriptive Reading

## Create A Scene Through AR Makr

### Activity

Student will create a scene in AR Makr and place up to 5 objects in the scene. They will then use screen recording and record a verbal description of what is happening in the scene, and include the use of prepositions in their verbal description.

### Objectives

Students will be able to

- Speak and represent confidently, coherently and cohesively for a variety of purposes, audiences, contexts and cultures
- Apply knowledge of grammatical rules at sentence level
- Generate ideas and explore different pathways that lead to solutions




### Extensions

Students can

- Create a scene and then send it to a partner for them to record their verbal description
- Observe the objects within the scene, then plan a storyline that links the various objects and record the audio story

## Have a go



- 1 Open . Tap on Start. Tap on + to Create Your Own Scene. Tap on Start. You will need to move the iPad around for it to detect a flat surface.
- 2 Lots of white dots will appear, tap on it so that it will recognise it as the plane for the scene. You can create your own shapes to place in the scene.
- 3 Tap on New and you can choose a shape to work on. Tap on the brush  and you can change the thickness of the brush stroke and colour by dragging the slider. Paint the shape, then tap .
- 4 Select the shape on the left and tap Place to locate it on the scene. Tap on the bottom right and you can choose an animation for it.
- 5 Move around with your iPad to observe how it looks like from different angles. Tap on New to insert a new shape. You can also use a photo from your Photos library or take a new picture.
- 6 Once the scene is set up, use screen recording with microphone switched on to explain about the position of shapes relative to each other.

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
