

# Doodle-Art

## Create An Animated GIF

### Activity

To extend on the creativity process, students will create movement of their doodle-art characters through the creation of an animated GIF. They will break down the movement of their character into several slides and consider how the storyboard will look like.

### Objectives

Students will be able to

- Explore and discover different ways to use tools to make art
- Share their artworks, intentions and art making process with others
- Identify essential elements of complex tasks, stay focused and persevere when he/she encounters difficulties and unexpected challenges




### Extensions

Students can

- Add pictures and colours to the background to create various scenes to enrich the doodle-art
- Add audio/ background music and import it into iMovie to create a scene
- Work with a small group of peers to create the characters and storyline for a movie

## Have a go



- 1 Open . Create a new document in Keynote. Tap on ⊕, then  and select Drawing.
- 2 The toolbar will appear . Change the colour by tapping on the colours, change the line thickness by tapping on the tool. Draw on the first slide.
- 3 Tap on the slide and select Duplicate. Alternatively, tap on the slide and select Copy. Paste the slide below the first. Draw on the second slide.
- 4 Tap on the slide and select Duplicate. Alternatively, tap on the slide and select Copy. Paste the slide below the second. Draw on the third slide. Continue until the doodle-art is completed.
- 5 Tap on 😊 and select Export, then Animated GIF. Change the Slide Range and tap on Export. Tap on Share and then Save Image.
- 6 The animated GIF will appear in your Photos library. You can insert it into another document or upload it to an online platform for sharing.
