### Objectives

















- Students can infer the ideas, feelings and meanings of visuals through the use of art elements and principles, media, process and/ or techniques. (LO1)
- Students can express personal ideas and opinions about what they see and experience. (LO1)
- Students can talk/write/draw/create visual about what they see. (LO2)
- Students can examine visuals from different perspectives. (LO3)

### Extensions

- Students to add the voice/commentary for the art work (this can be ether done by built-in screen recording or AR overlaying the video of the commentary.)
- Students to create AR experience for their digital art via Artivive app.

## Have a go



- 1 Tap , and tap  start a new project. \* go to Setting —> Privacy —> Photos —> to allow permission for Photoshops Mix to read and write.
- 2 Tap  to import images from photos or tap  create new canvas. After selecting the desired image (being the first image layer), add second image by tapping  on the right.
- 3 Use the tool bar to manipulate the images.        
- 4 Tap  to export images to  Camera Roll
- 5 Close Photoshops Mix and tap  to open your image in Photos for uploading to desired online learning space.

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
