

Writing and Representing

Story Mapping

Activity

As a pre-writing task, students are to plan by using one of the graphic organiser templates. They are to identify the purpose, audience, setting, beginning, middle and the end. While brainstorming ideas, encourage students to record their thought using the build in function.

Objectives












- Students can generate, select and organise ideas for writing and representing creatively for a variety of purposes, audiences, contexts and cultures.
- Students can develop, organise and express ideas coherently, creatively and critically in writing and representing to produce text for a variety of purpose, audience, context and culture.
- Students can review and revise drafts to improve focus and clarity in expression of meaning through self-reflection, teacher/peer conferencing.

Extensions

- Teacher can create extra support for extra scaffold for differentiation.
- Teacher can add audio instruction and feedback to support learning.
- Students can export the draft work and share it via SLS for peer feedback.
- Peers are able to provide feedback using markup (image) and audio (keynote) tools.

Have a go



- 1 Go to , look for the template shared by your teacher.
- 2 To add text, line and shapes for explanation, tap  on the top right hand corner, and under shapes  basic shapes to locate text. To modify text and shapes, tap to select first, then tap  to modify the style.
- 3 Use Apple Pencil to tap on the screen in Keynote to activate the drawing mode or tap  on the top right hand corner, and under  and tap drawing to activate drawing. Press **Done** on the top right corner to leave drawing mode.
- 4 Tap  on the top right hand corner, and under  Record Audio to verbalise and record personal reflection.
- 5 Tap  export to movie or images. Tap  to save video/images. Close Keynote and tap  to open your video/image in Photos.

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
