

# Headlines

## Speaking and Representing

### Activity

Referencing from Visible Thinking: Headlines, students are to first listen to teacher's pre recorded audio in the Clips template, and write a headline for the topic/issue/content heard that captured the most important aspect that should be remembered.

After class discussion, students may go back to template and update the headlines if necessary.

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### Objectives

- Students able to recall and organise key content in text by summarising.
- Students able to identify details to extract specific information.
- Students able to identify main ideas (e.g. key points of an explanation or argument)
- Students able to refine own thinking through discussions.





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### Extensions

- Teacher can create extra support for extra scaffold for differentiation.
- Teacher can add audio instruction and feedback to support learning.
- Students can export the draft work and share it via SLS for peer feedback.
- Peers are able to provide feedback using markup (image) and audio (keynote) tools.

## Have a go



- 1 To create project template, Teacher should first open Clips  and tap + to begin a new project.
- 2 Select **POSTERS** at the bottom of the screen and choose the appropriate poster for the project. Double tap on the text and replace with appropriate title. Tap **Apply** in the top right-hand corner of the screen.
- 3 Swipe up the  and record.
- 4 Export , tap **Export Project**  and save to files for future use.

*Suggests teachers to use Basic or Photographics Posters to reduce the animated time.*

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
