Activity

In groups of 3, students are to create a local story about their school, community or country. This can be with reference to an event in the recent or distant past. Students should consider the following: What is the story about? How will we ensure the story is told fairly and accurately? How will we engage our audience?

Objectives














- Students can generate, develop and organise ideas respectfully as individuals and collaboratively in a planned situation.
- Students can speak and represent ideas confidently, coherently and cohesively for a variety of purposes, audiences, contexts and cultures.
- Students can recognise and apply word stress patterns accurately.
- Students can verify the accuracy, credibility and currency of a piece of information. (CCI)
- Students can generate ideas and explore different pathways to respond to an issue/challenge. (CIT)
- Students can identify the essential elements of multiple tasks/roles, stay focused on them and persevere when he/she encounters difficulties and unexpected challenges. (CIT)

Extensions

- Challenge students to tell the same story from a different perspective with original music.
- Teacher can create podcasts for students to listen to as part of their revision.

Have a go



- 1 Open , tap  to create new document. Select **TRACKS** and search for Audio Recorder. Select Voice  or tap More Sound, locate Vocals -> Narrator. Be ready to speak, read a script or narrate.
- 2 Tap on  at the top right-hand corner of the screen. Tap on 8 Bars > Automatic. Turn off the Metronome by tapping .
- 3 Press record . Tap  when finished. View recording by tapping on . Move  to the desired place to re-record/restart at a specific timing.
- 4 View new recording by tapping on  and edit the blue bar by double tapping on it. Tap  on the left bottom to add background music (refer to Create Music for instructions).
- 5 Once you are satisfied with your new soundtrack, tap  exit to the main page. Long hold the soundtrack to bring the manual **Share**  to export the sound file.

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
