

# **Feedback and Self Reflection**

### Screen Recording

#### **Activity**

In conjunction with the built-in Markup function, students can add their voice to explain their work via the Screen Recording function.

Examples: Teachers can provide audio feedback while marking students work. Students are able to self reflect on their written work or read the text out-aloud as a form of self assessment.

### **Objectives**

- Students can review and revise drafts to improve focus and clarity in expression of meaning through self-reflection, teacher/peer conferencing.
- Students can proof read and edit drafts by correcting language features for grammatical accuracy and clarity of meaning.
- Students can recount relevant experiences which they has learnt from (CIT2).

#### **Extensions**

- Teachers can provide images as stimulus material for students to revise on their picture discussion.
- Students can work on their mind map first take an image (markup to add more information if needed), then to record their work.

## Have a go



- Open , select Control Centre. Under Customise Controls, add Screen Recording by tapping .
- 2 Tap and find the image.
- Tap on edit on the top right corner of a photo. Tap on and tap on to call out the markup panel.
- 4 Change the color or type of markup tools if needed
- Swipe down from the top right corner of the screen to access Control Center.

  Long press the . Turn on the microphone. Press Start Recording.



Swipe down Control Centre to stop recording. Go to to edit the start and end before submitting to teacher.
