Activity

In place of page 5 in the activity book, students can design their poster of a place of interest in Keynote and make it interactive by adding animations and export as GIFs before uploading to SLS.

Objectives







Students can leverage on their design thinking and creativity to create an appealing poster GIF to attract more attention

Extensions

Students can explore tracing the outline of icons from the place of interest to make the poster more abstract, or even animate with line draw before showing the actual photograph in the GIF

Have a go



- 1 Open Keynote , create a blank deck, Tap on , then  to picture of the place of interest you found on the internet.
- 2 Tap on  >  to insert a text box to add descriptions or captions to bring attention to the poster.
- 3 Duplicate the second slide. Amplify the change in variable. Be sure to keep the other variables constant.
Duplicate more slides and amend them to extend the GIF if necessary.
- 4 Export the Animated GIF into the Photos library.
Tap on  > Export > Animated GIF. Ensure Slide Range includes all the slides with images.
Tap on Export and then Share. Then select Save Image.
- 5 The animated GIF will appear in your Photos library. You can insert it into another document or upload it directly for your students.

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
