

Explore with Live Loops

Use GarageBand to Make a Piece of Music

Activity

Students will be able to explore with live loops and create music by putting the different loops together. They would not need to know how to play any instruments yet, but would be able to piece the different sounds together. This would require them to consider about the effect of putting different sounds together.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Create and perform soundscapes to a given stimulus, and produce graphic notations of their soundscapes
- Create a soundscape or melodic composition using digital tools
- Explains his/her reasoning and decisions





Extensions

Students can

- Add their voice into the piece of music

Have a go



- 1 Open  . Tap on + and select Live Loops. Tap on a genre of music that you would like to create.
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- 2 Tap on the individual cell to listen to the sound it plays. You can press a few cells consecutively to hear how they sound together.
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- 3 Tap on the trigger ^ at the bottom of screen to play the whole column.
.....
- 4 Tap on ■ to stop the music. Tap on ● to record the sounds as you play them.
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- 5 Tap on | and drag it to the right. It will allow you to adjust the volume for each individual track. Drag | to the left once you are done with the adjustments.
.....
- 6 Tap  once you are done with the creation. Tap and long hold on the thumbnail once you are done. Select share . Tap Song, then tap Share. Select Open in, and select Save to Files .

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
