

# Add Music Tracks

## Use GarageBand to Add Music to Voice Recording

### Activity

Students will be able to add music alongside their voice recording in GarageBand. They can consider how they can use music to evoke different types of emotions and how that could affect the overall mood.

### Objectives

Students will be able to

- Sing with accuracy, clarity and reasonable technique
- Create a soundscape or melodic composition using digital tools
- Generate ideas to respond to an issue/challenge


### Extensions


Students can

- Work in small groups to create a piece of music that is influenced by their own culture
- Use the music to create a video with a storyline



## Have a go






- 1 Open . Tap on + and select Live Loops. Tap on New.

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- 2 Tap the loop icon  at the top right. Listen to the loops and select one that you like.

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- 3 Long press on the track and drag it to the left so that it appears on the screen. You can move it left or right based on where you would like it to start.

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- 4 You can also drag the yellow border to shorten the duration of the loop. Tap on  and drag it to the right. It will allow you to adjust the volume for each individual track. Drag  to the left once you are done with the adjustments.

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- 5 Add as many tracks as you would like. Tap  once you are done with the creation. Tap and long hold on the thumbnail once you are done. Select share .

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- 6 Tap Song, then tap Share. Select Open in, and select Save to Files .

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
