

Record Voice

Use GarageBand to Record Voice

Activity

Students will be able to record their voice in GarageBand and be creative with how they want their voice to sound like. This can help them to explore different ways of playing with their voice.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Imitate rhythmic and melodic patterns of increasing complexity using body percussion, voice and classroom instruments
- Respond to changes in the elements of music as well as its mood through movement


Extensions

Students can




- Build on their music piece in GarageBand by including the use of other instruments
- Add their friends' voices
- Include soundscapes to personalize their music piece





- 1 Open . Tap on + and select Live Loops.

- 2 Flick left/right to Audio Recorder. Tap on Voice.

- 3 Tap on  to turn it off, so that it turns grey . Tap Record  and start speaking.

- 4 Slow down the speaking speed slightly. Pause between each sentence.

- 5 Tap on  when you are done. Tap on  once done. Select the file, and Share .
- 6 Tap Song, then tap Share. Select Open in, and select Save to Files . You can now upload it onto a different platform.

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
